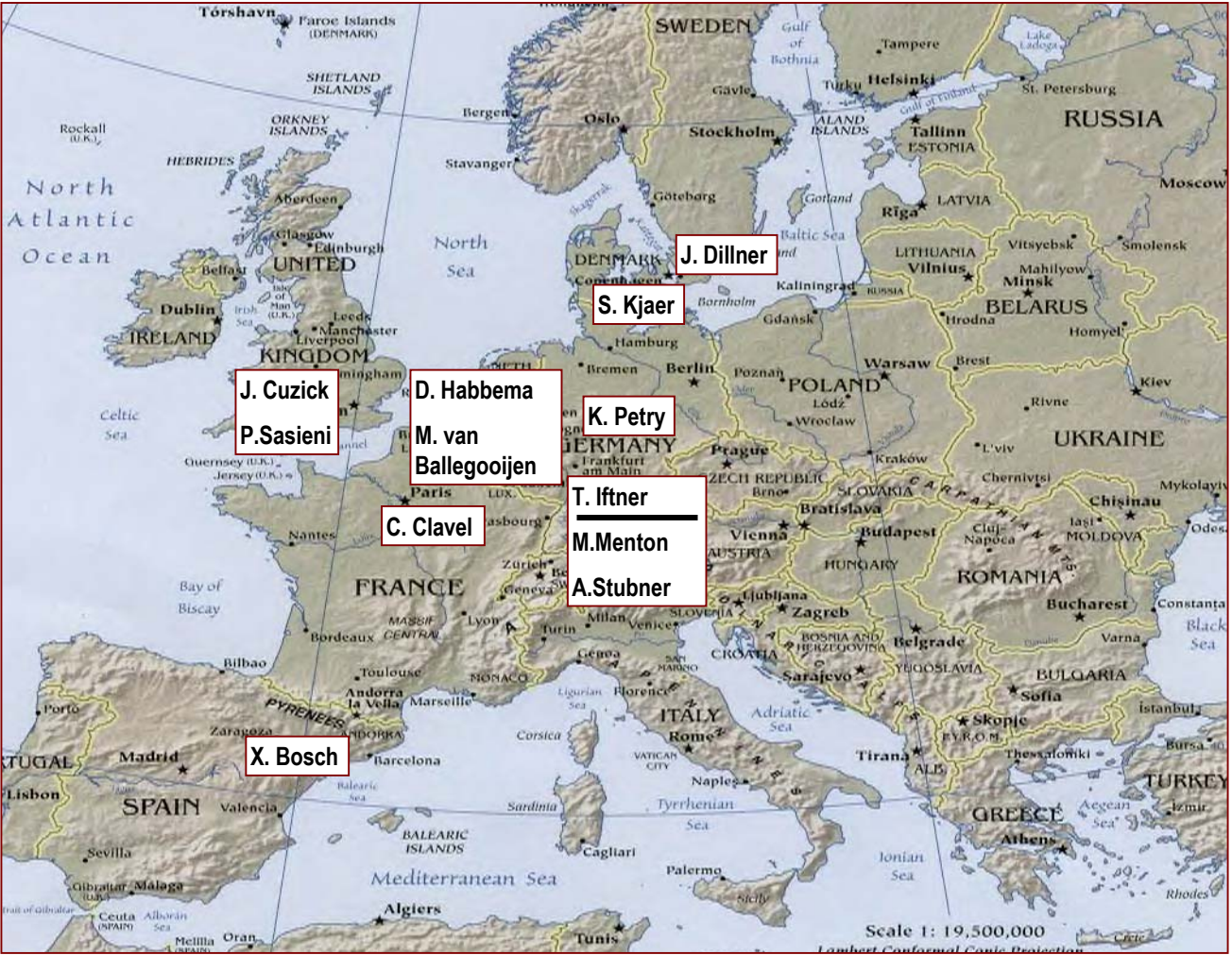

- **Define the predictive value of a negative HPV test result in combination with or without cytology over the longer term (five years - ten years) and collect healthcare cost data**
- **perform cost/benefit analysis and modelling**

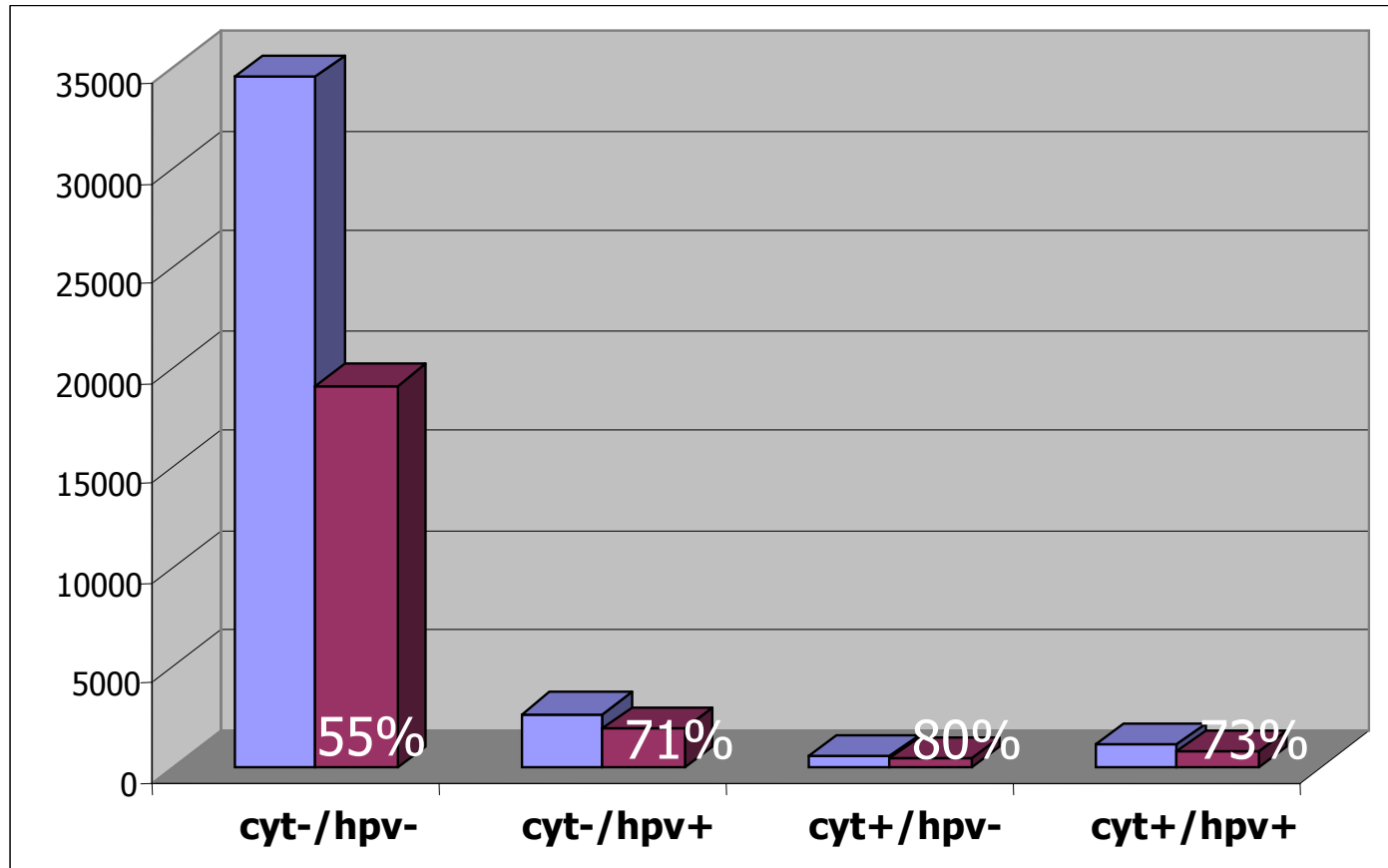
Establish long-term PPV and NPV of HPV/cytology testing for 6 European countries

Collect existing cervical cancer screening and healthcare cost data for all countries participating in the project

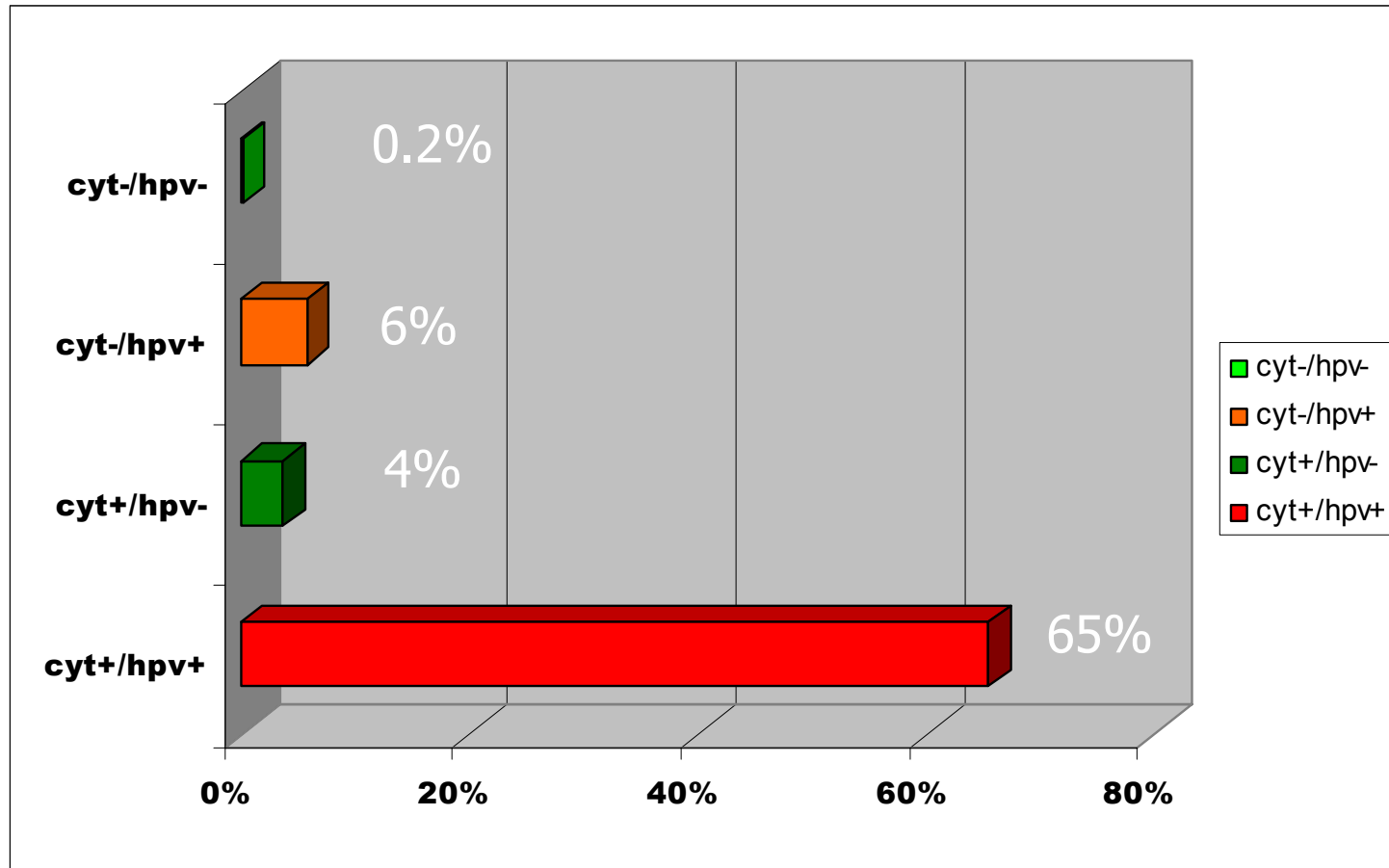
